- Continuing Education pursuing a career in Mechanical/Trades related field
- Financial Need: A student in need of financial assistance.

The High Lakes Car Club is again offering a scholarship for 2026 graduates and students continuing their education and pursuing a career in the Automotive, Mechanical, Technical Design, Engineering or Machinist trades.

Our scholarship is not limited to a student pursuing a four-year college degree, although we welcome applications from those students, but we also welcome applications from students who are looking at a Trade School or a two-year certificate or apprenticeship, if his or her interest is in this field. Attitude, aptitude, work ethic, and stability are more important than grade point averages, especially if the student has shown a marked improvement in grades, attendance, and studies.

Applications are available to students attending La Pine, Gilchrist, and North Lake High Schools. Completed applications, with reference letters, must be submitted to your Counselor, who will forward to and be received by the Scholarship Committee no later than May 20, 2026.
